
Tips to spot and prevent the spread of MSX (H. nelsoni)



WHAT TO LOOK FOR

- Valves slow to close when disturbed
- Decreased rate of growth, no new shell growth
- Juvenile oysters may have pale digestive glands
- Oysters that are over 2 years old are particularly affected. May have high mortality.





HOW TO PREVENT SPREAD

- Do not introduce oysters from a MSX endemic area to new areas
- Rinse off boats and gear with fresh water
- Leave equipment in direct sunlight for 48 hrs

PROTECTING THE INDUSTRY

- Do not move oysters from infected to non-infected areas
- Report unauthorized movements
- Report mortality events
